Re : Pre-Admission Testing (PAT) for GXM samples

Please be informed that the validity of Pre-admission Testing (PAT) for GXM samples collected at **OUTPATIENT SPECIALIST CLINICS** will be extended from 28 days to **45 days**, effective from **1 March, 2021 8am**.

- The criteria for PAT remains the same: The patient HAVE NOT received any blood transfusion or is/was pregnant (including miscarriages/abortions) within the preceding 3 months.
- Please note that the GXM sample for PAT must be collected by GXM PAT certified/ trained nurse.
- 3) If the patient is eligible for PAT, the Pre-Admission Crossmatch Declaration Form DLM-FORM-GEN-014 has to be signed by the patient and the signed form to be filed in the patient's case notes
- 4) If the patient have been transfused or is/was pregnant (including miscarriages/ abortions) in the last 3 months, GXM will **NOT** be taken as PAT. Instead a new GXM will be collected when the patient is admitted for surgery.
- 5) If the patient were to receive any transfusion or become pregnant within the PAT validity period prior to surgery, the patient is required to inform the clinic.
  - The clinic or the Coordinator must inform Blood Transfusion Service at ext 22305 to invalidate the PAT GXM. A new GXM sample will then be taken upon admission.
