Cellophane Tape Method for Collection of Perianal Specimen

Use a piece of clear cellulose tape (4-5 X 0.75 inch). Anchor one end to the underside of a 3 X 1 inch Hold the slide against a tongue depressor and lift the slide. Fold the tape over the near end of the slide long portion of the tape from the slide. and smooth the sticky side down the length of the slide. Attach a paper tab to the free end of the slide for labelling. Loop the tape over the end of the depressor to Hold the tape and slide against the tongue expose the gummed surface. Press the gummed surfaces against several areas of Replace tape on slide. the perianal region. Smooth tape with cotton or gauze. Specimens are best obtained a few hours after the person has retired: at 10:00 to 11:00 pm, or the first thing in the morning before a bowel movement or bath.
